Born in Mexico City on 8 August 1953, he is married with three daughters.

He graduated in law from the Free School of Law, and subsequently obtained a master's degree and a doctorate in law (*University of Navarra, Spain, 1998*).

He has held the following offices: Full-time professor and researcher at the Free School of Law (1978-2007); part-time professor in the Faculty of Law of the Panamerican University (1982-1985 and 1989-2007); part-time associate researcher at the Centre for University Studies of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (CESU) (1985-1989); director of the Institute for Mexican Culture in Spain and Cultural Advisor at the Embassy of Mexico in Madrid (2007-2013); ambassador in Ecuador (since 2013).
