POPE FRANCIS ASSURES THEM, AS WELL AS THE RELIEF WORKERS AND HELPERS, OF HIS SPIRITUAL CLOSENESS AND INVOKES GOD'S PROTECTION AND ASSISTANCE FOR ALL.
